# ÅGame # 1: Holiday Trivia Challenge

Time: 20 minutes | Supplies: None (just questions!)

## How to Play:

- Divide your team into small groups of 3-5 people
- Read trivia questions aloud
- Teams write down answers
- Award points for correct answers; team with most points wins

#### Trivia Questions:

- In what year did "A Christmas Story" premiere? (1983)
- What holiday is celebrated for eight nights? (Hanukkah)
- In "Home Alone," where is the McCallister family traveling when they leave Kevin behind? (Paris)
- What is the best-selling holiday song of all time? ("White Christmas" by Bing Crosby)

Try your hand with AI to generate more questions and answers...be sure to do a QA check on those answers!
